
Denk mal - ein Denkmal!




Den Teilnehmern am Projekt wurden 7 Fragen gestellt.

An der Befragung, die online durchgeführt wurde, haben 56 Personen aus 6 Ländern teilgenommen. Hier die Ergebnisse:


1. How much did you like the project work (in percent from 0 to 100)




2. How much did you learn?



3. **Could you improve your knowledge of foreign languages?**




4. **Did you meet new people WITHIN YOUR SCHOOL?**

5. **Did you meet new friends from foreign countries?**




- 1 They are close friends now.
